So 4♠+3 will not be too bad – maybe 40% at worst.</p> <p>There are 13 easy tricks here via 2 Heart ruffs in the South hand. If South learns that his partner has 7 Spades to the KQ and the ♥A and more than a minimum hand he will be able to count 13 tricks.</p> <p>Even bidding 6♠ will be a huge result for N/S as getting to slam depends on what North rebids after 1♠-2♦. 3♠ seems an overbid while 2♠ is an underbid. Certainly the 3♠ bidders will get to slam while the 2♠ bidders most likely will not. East's 8 HCP and good 5-card Club suit should tempt him to try for game.</p> <p>Declarer has 9 tricks with the aid of the Heart finesse. He might still have 3 Spades so South's 3♦ is Fourth Suit Forcing asking for more information.</p> <p>Declarer should run the ♠10 from dummy (unless East covers it). But whether you finesse the Queen first or run the 10 on the first round of Spades it seems you get 4 Spade tricks anyway.</p> <p>Those declarers who will berate their partners for putting them into 4♠ will be pleasantly surprised to end up with 11 tricks and a very good score. It won't be obvious to N/S that they should Double 2♠ and try for the magic +200 in 2♠-1. And even if they do double 2♠ they might not find the ♠A lead to beat it. North doesn't really have a 'Double' of West's 1♥ opening – he has too many Hearts and he has only a minimum 12-15 hand. No doubt some North's will start with a Double. They won't come to any trouble on this hand because West will rebid his Heart suit.

West will play in 2 or 3♥ and most likely make 9 tricks for a flat board.

How do we hold declarer to 8 tricks?

Any North player who finds the killing Diamond switch after a top Spade lead, to kill the entry to the Club suit should be playing on the Irish Open Team!
