Most Norths will take some action in third seat – either $1 \triangleq \text{ or } 2 \triangleq$. Those who open $1 \triangleq \text{ might have trouble}$ stopping below $3 \triangleq$, while the $2 \triangleq \text{ openers should be}$ left undisturbed in the safe haven of $2 \triangleq$.

Declarer should lose 2 trump tricks, 2 aces and a Heart trick. Those declarers in $3 \bigstar$ will somehow have to talk the defenders out of their Heart trick – as by getting East to waste his \bigstar A on thin air or by getting East to open the Heart suit first – and to be fair that \blacktriangledown Q looks like a might attractive opening lead.

North has a perfect 'Yarborough' – a rare bird indeed! No card higher than a nine - 1 hand in approximately every 2000.

East will open 1NT if playing a weak NT or $1 \bullet$ if playing a Strong NT. South will bid some number of Hearts (between 1 and 4). E/W have enough points to be in game and on this board they will be very happy if they miss their Spade fit altogether and play in 3NT because N/S can get a beautiful crossruff going to defeat $4 \bullet$ by 3 tricks.

If South gets to play in a Heart contract he will most likely be doubled and make 7 tricks - 5 Heart tricks and 2 Aces.

This is not an easy game to bid and yet some pairs won't have any trouble bidding it. The first question is for North. What action does he take over West's 1. opening bid? 1NT is out because of the lack of a Club stopper. Double will show the strength of the hand and will certainly get you to game somewhere but probably the best bid is a simple 1. overcall.

The second question is for South. How do you respond to North? If North doubles maybe South can cue bid $2 \div$ to show his majors? If North simply overcalls $1 \diamond$ will South have the courage to bid at all? Still getting to play in a major suit contract even if only a partscore will score ok. And there will be a few pairs going down in $4 \checkmark$.
