Given the TWO heart cues North will likely lead the DQ. Declarer needs the CK to be right and assumes North's minor is diamonds.

Cash the HA. Spade to the King (in case spades are 4/0). Spade back to the ace (retaining the SQ as an entry). Club to K and ace. HK pitching a club. CA and C9 ruffing out South's marked Jack. Spade to the Q. Cash two winning clubs pitching 2 losing diamonds making +1.

Reaching and making 6S will be a big score.
