If North has 4-1 then declarer cannot succeed but if South has the 4-1 then declarer can succeed if he starts by playing the $\neg K$ and $\neg Q$ first now when North shows out on the second spade declarer will have the ^A10 sitting over South's ^J. W. Well Played.
