
Club Stratified Sim Pairs

Welcome to the ninth 'Club Stratified Sim Pairs'. Our commentator today is Heather Dhondy, experienced bridge teacher and writer.

How stratification works and which stratum you should be in. There are four strata:


- 1. Stratum 'A' is open to everyone but if either member of the pair is a Tournament Master or above you will be in this stratum and can only get master points from the overall ranking.
- 2. If both of you are below the rank of Tournament Master you will be 'B' stratum;
- 3. both below Master means you will be in 'C' stratum and
- 4. both below District Master will make you 'D' stratum.


Blue points and local points will be awarded to the top third of the overall ranking list. In addition the top third of each stratum will get blue points and local points. If you are entitled to overall points and points for your stratum, you will only get the higher of the awards – you won't get two lots of points! Master points cannot be allocated until after the event is finalised, usually about three weeks. Please keep your scorecard for that period. If we find any unusual scores we may need to contact the club scorer and also the players. Full results may be found at <u>www.ebu.co.uk/sims/</u>

What do you overcall with the North hand after West opens 1A? The hand is strong, but the hearts are weak, so I would prefer to overcall 1NT. On this deal it doesn't work out very well as you are likely to make more tricks in hearts.

There will, however, be some East-Wests getting into trouble after opening a weak NT with the West hand, so however you do in hearts or NTs as North, you will not be able to compete with the penalties being collected at other tables.

Playing in 1NT with a diamond lead, you are a little short of entries for both major suit finesses, however leading spades from hand will get you two tricks in the suit and the most the defence can take will be one spade and three clubs. So, provided you take the heart finesse through the opening bidder you will make nine tricks.

East-West will do well to get into the auction here since 2 his making, but it is not obvious to do so. They may even end up with an overtrick since the normal heart lead does not get the defence off to a good start. Declarer will probably duck this and now, unless North switches to a diamond to get the force going, declarer will have time to establish a fourth club trick as well as ruffing the heart and drawing trumps.


In 2, declarer has a trick to lose in each suit, however on the singleton diamond lead, the defence can take a ruff and switch to clubs. Now they are in a position to take a second ruff as well as establishing their club trick for one down.



6 is always making when the king is singleton onside, however it is unlikely to be reached. Firstly, South will cramp them for room by pre-empting, but even left to their own devices, the rise in popularity of Roman Keycard Blackwood (and rightly so) mean that small slams on the finesse of the king of trumps are seldom bid these days. Declarer needs to avoid leading the \$10 from the South hand!

South will probably pre-empt to $3 \vee$ and should then shut up. A venture to the five level will prove too expensive, or even worse might push them up to the making slam.

4. is a normal contract and I would expect almost everyone to be playing there. The defence need to be attacking trumps early on in order to stop the overtrick. If West leads a diamond, declarer will ruff and play a heart in an attempt to get to hand to lead a club towards the king. Declarer's plan will be to ruff clubs in the South hand. West should foil this plan by switching to a trump now. That ensures that when in with the A, another trump can be led, and declarer will be unable to ruff both clubs. Having said that, if they do find this defence, declarer might as well run the A if it isn't covered since East has no more trumps. If it is covered, the ten and nine of clubs are falling and the eight is established, so declarer may make their overtrick anyway.

If the auction begins with 1NT by West, and a transfer to hearts, South will back in with a reopening double, and buy the contract in 2. Although there are just two diamond and a heart to lose, the trump break prevents declarer from being able to ruff the third diamond in the North hand so just nine tricks are possible.

If North-South defend 2♥, they will probably begin with ♣Q. This isn't the best start, however by cashing a second club and switching to a low trump, declarer will be unable to make it. The defence get off to a better start if they can find a spade lead. Now the forcing defence will take the contract two down, but it still won't compensate for those making 140 in spades.

This will be a popular contract with the field divided between those making eleven tricks and those making twelve.

On a diamond lead, the defence will cash the first two rounds of the suit and declarer will have the remainder of the tricks. On a heart lead from the South hand, declarer will wrap up twelve tricks in quick fashion, discarding two diamonds from the West hand on a heart and a long club. On a club lead, declarer has a decision to take. Having drawn trumps and knowing that one diamond will go on the long club, do you risk the heart finesse? If it works you make twelve, but if it fails you will only make ten tricks. Are you feeling lucky?
